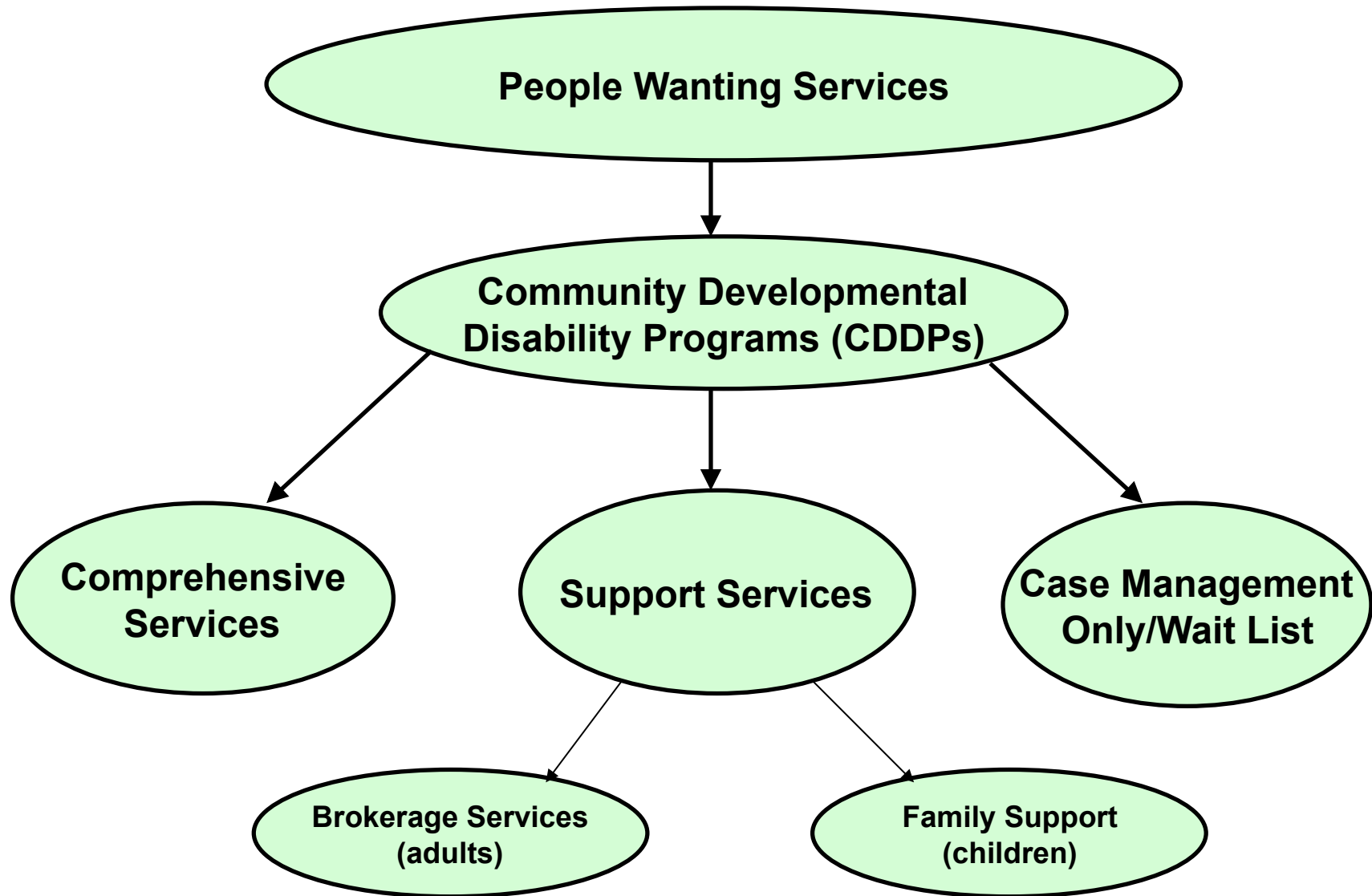

Oregon Developmental Disability Service System – Basic Overview

- Total served is approaching **18,000** individuals.
- Children/families (30%) and adults (70%).
- Biennial budget is approximately **\$1.3 Billion** for Community Based Services.
- 100% services are in community settings.
- Administered by State Department of Human Services, Seniors and People with Disabilities, Office of DD Services
- Oregon's service system designed on county structure, has an active network of providers, and benefits from a strong advocacy community

What Does the DD System Look Like?



Comprehensive Services

- **RESIDENTIAL SERVICES**
 - Group Homes
 - Foster Homes
 - Supported Living Services
 - Intensive In-Home Supports (annual plans over \$21K per year)
- **ALLIED SERVICES**
 - Employment-Non Work Activities
 - Transportation Services

Support Services

- **SUPPORT SERVICES FOR ADULTS**
 - Available for adults over 18 years not in a comprehensive service
 - Individuals referred by CDDP
 - In-Home less than \$21K per annual plan
 - Services arranged and monitored via Support Service Brokerages
- **FAMILY SUPPORT**
 - For children under 18 years and their families
 - Services arranged and monitored via CDDP's
 - Direct services funded by CDDP's with state contract resources
 - Children's case management provided by CDDP's

What are Brokerage or Support Services?

- Services arranged and provided in the home of the individual (usually still living with their family).
- Based on the concepts of self-determination and self-direction.
- Are designed to enhance, not substitute for, the supports a person is already receiving.
- Usually with a defined benefit/funding limit.
- For adults (18 years or older) these services are implemented through Support Service Brokerages.
- voluntary partial entitlement

Support Service Brokerages

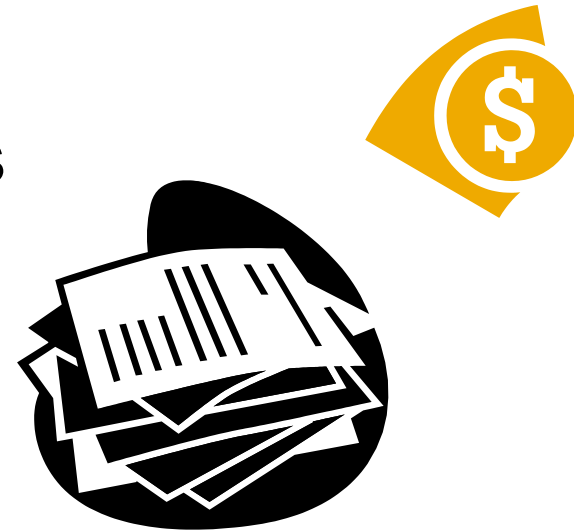
- Organizations developed for the specific purpose of providing Support Services for Adults
- There are 12 Brokerages. At least one for every area of the state.
- Currently 8,000 individuals are served.

Support Service Brokerages cont



Access to a Personal Agent

- Defined amount of money to purchase services
- Fiscal Intermediary Services
 - Employer Agent
 - Vendor Payments



Support Service Brokerages cont

- Purchasing Services:
 - Must be disability related and a "I Benefit".-to help functioning in society / address disability
 - Cannot supplant other available resources
 - Schools and or VR/OIB
 - natural supports.

The BIG GOAL....

- People with developmental disabilities are employed at the same rate as their peers without disabilities
- **OREGON** “Employment is the gateway to full citizenship”
- The economic situation is no reason for us to abandon our vision and values.
- ODDS Key Performance Measure is a 5% improvement in integrated employment per year

Comp Services

- Cuts in Admin or Comp Services
- Reduce Admin by 10% and eliminate QA
- Loss of non work services for 2000

Brokerage Services

- Cuts To Brokerages
- Reduce Admin by 10% and eliminate QA
- Less \$\$ for 18-21 year olds
- Eliminate GF Only population
- Some change in benefits
